

#### NOTICE

Do not at any time attach wear insert or remove wear insert from seed firmer while attached to planter. Remove seed firmer while doing maintenance. Beware of all pinch points. Do not backup planter while firmer is down. Always be moving forward when lowering planter.

# Remove disk guard

Remove depth gage wheels, remove scraper, remove scraper guards, and disc blades.



# Assemble adapter

Slide mounting block into bracket arm. Start with the bolts in the first and third hole from the top of the bracket arm.



# **Tighten bolts**

Tighten bolts. Adjust location of bolts on the mounting arm to fit your pressure and soil conditions.



## **Confirm look**

Confirm all pieces are securely tightened.



## Side view for placement\*

Center mounting block into planter and tighten bolts equally on both sides.



## Attached with screws

Tighten bolts once mounting block is centered. Replace factory bolts with Flo-Rite™ bolts to attach firmer & scraper guards.
